Investigations	\$0.08 B	\$0.10 B	\$0.02 B
Construction	\$1.24 B	\$2.22 B	\$0.98 B
Operations & Maintenance	\$2.87 B	\$2.96 B	\$0.09 B
MR&T	\$0.22 B	\$0.22 B	\$0.00 B
<u>Other</u>	<u>\$0.42 B</u>	<u>\$0.47 B</u>	<u>\$0.05 B</u>
Total	\$4.83 B	\$5.97 B	\$1.14 B

Answers

- How bad is the FY21 USACE (CW) budget request?
